Flat glass exam

Considered a must for anyone involved in the installation and supply of flat glass film, this exam gives you a broad and thorough understanding of the concepts surrounding residential and commercial window film.

Modules include solar energy and heat transfer, glass and glazing systems, solar control and safety and security window film.

Participants must study the Flat Glass Education Guide, a hard copy book that is posted to you on registration. This is included in the cost below. You can refer to the guide while you take the 100 multiple choice question exam, which needs to be completed in three hours. You will receive a certificate once the exam is successfully completed.
